Be a Dog or Cat Foster Carer....

Our work is entirely dependent upon dog and cat foster carers. Every foster carer enables us to save more pets from death at pounds. Being a foster carer is a great way to have a pet without the expense and long term commitment of owning one. You can take time off from fostering when you want to travel or have a break

All you need to provide is a fully fenced yard, shelter, food, and love for a dog or cat in need. Rescue pays for all veterinary expenses and medical supplies such as flea and worm treatment. You can choose the type of dog or cat (breed, size, age, etc) you foster.

You may say "Oh, I couldn't give the dog away!" but in reality yes, you can. Just remember that your foster dog or cat will go to a great home and then you can save another dog or cat from death row. You can always adopt your foster pet if you really can't bear to say goodbye.


