

If You'd Like to Leave a Legacy....

If you would like to leave a legacy to Dog Rescue Newcastle you may include the following paragraph when updating or writing your Will:

"I leave \$ to Dog Rescue Newcastle ABN 92 544 122 852 for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the secretary, treasurer, or other proper officer of that organisation is a sufficient receipt for my Trustee and that my Trustee is not obliged to see to the application of this bequest."

The above wording may need to be adapted for your particular circumstances. For example you may wish to leave a percentage of your assets to Dog Rescue Newcastle rather than a lump sum, or perhaps a particular valuable asset, such as shares, an antique, or real estate. You should seek legal advice before using it.

Who We Are...

We are a wholly volunteer, not-for-profit, organisation. Our mission is to rescue abandoned dogs from death row at pounds and put them into foster homes until we can find permanent homes for them. All money which we raise is used entirely to pay for the costs involved in the rescue and care of dogs.

All donations are tax deductible.

Our History...

Dog Rescue Newcastle was officially established in May 2008. We initially concentrated our efforts on small dogs. A year later we were able to take larger dogs and we now take almost any type of dog, as long as we have a carer available.

Since formation, Dog Rescue Newcastle has rehomed more than 2,600 dogs and over 600 cats that would otherwise now be dead. You can read about some of the pets which we have saved on the "Success Stories" pages on our website. This is a great achievement considering our size and funds.

Where Our Dogs Come From...

Our priority is to save as many dogs as we can from "Death Row" in local pounds. These are the ones with the most desperate need. They have only days, sometimes hours to live. When we are able, we accept private surrenders from people who can no longer keep their dogs.

We rescue dogs from Port Stephens Pound, Wyong Pound, Singleton Pound, Muswellbrook Pound, and beyond.

Dogs in pounds are perfectly healthy, normal family pets. They have become lost and remain unclaimed, or are surrendered by owners who can no longer care for them. Occasionally we find a pet who has suffered from neglect, such as Victor, below:



Victor was close to death from starvation. His dedicated foster carer nursed him back to health and now he is very happy in his permanent home.

Dog Rescue Newcastle receives no public funding and our vet bills are thousands of dollars each month for desexing, vaccination, medications and other necessities for our dogs in foster care.

Proceeds of your Bequest will help support Dog Rescue Newcastle's efforts in saving more dogs on death row in local pounds and giving them a second chance of lives in loving new homes.

Working on ones will is never easy, but it is important task to make sure your wishes are carried out. If you don't have a valid will your estate can be divided according to legislation and not according to your wishes.
